## From the Pastor—COME, LORD JESUS

This period leading up to Christmas is a treasured time of preparing for the celebration of Jesus’ birth. I love that there are special things we bring out only at this time of the year—carols , greenery, lights, candles (gasp!), and the like. Though it’s enjoyable to celebrate with the familiar, some feel the pressure to put a new spin on things or present the well-known stories in a new light.

I’ve heard my fair share of advent sermons over the years, and some clever preachers have connected the time of advent to Christ’s *second* coming, not just his first. I considered this clever because it seems like a twist on the true intent of the season. Turns out, though, I was mistaken.

According to historians, it was in the sixth century AD that Western Christians began observing a period of forty days before Epiphany (January 6) explicitly tied to the coming of Christ. But the coming (Latin, *adventus*) the church was focusing on at this time was the future return of Christ, not his birth! Only in the medieval period did this come to be associated with the incarnation.

Of course, the Bible does not direct us to observe advent (or Christmas, for that matter), but it is a valuable opportunity for us to reflect and reorient. We remember that the birth in Bethlehem was not an isolated event designed to facilitate gift-giving and nostalgia. On the contrary, it is the first **stage in a divine plan that culminates in Jesus’ second coming**. In the prophecies of the Old Testament, both comings are part of one grand intervention by which God is rescuing and repairing all things that are broken in the world.

I have never thought of Charles Wesley’s hymn, “Love Divine, All Loves Excelling,” as an advent hymn, but it points us in exactly the right direction, so I leave you with a few of its lines. The first verse mentions the “joy of heav’n to earth come down,” the third verse pleads, “Come, Almighty, to deliver,” and the last verse yearns for the completion of this grand endeavor:

*Finish then Thy new creation; pure and spotless let us be.  
Let us see Thy great salvation perfectly restored in Thee.  
Changed from glory into glory, till in heav’n we take our place,  
till we cast our crowns before Thee, lost in wonder, love, and praise.*

May this advent season find us longing for HIS great salvation!
